The Integrated Case Management-Complexity Assessment Grid (ICM-CAG), a complexity assessment tool used in the Integrated Case Management Process

Speaker: [Roger G. Kathol, MD, CPE](#)



Roger G. Kathol is President of Cartesian Solutions, Inc.™ and an innovative health strategist in the development of integrated programs and systems for patients with illness complexity, many of whom have concurrent physical health (PH) and mental health/substance use disorders (MH/SUDs). Dr. Kathol is board certified in internal medicine, psychiatry, and medical management with extensive clinical and administrative experience gained during 25 years as a physician/teacher/researcher at the University of Iowa, and 10 years as an international health management (HM) consultant. His background ideally positions him to assist stakeholders in the health industry create integrated PH and MH/SUD solutions which improve care quality, augment outcomes, and lower total health care and health-related costs.

Assisting Dr. Kathol will be Linda Crowley, RN, CCM, with case examples. Using the Integrated Case Management-Complexity Assessment Grid (ICM-CAG), you will see how based on level of complexity the case manager can prioritize associated barriers to improvement in various domains, build care plans, and assist patients as they stabilize and/or return to health. The ICM integrated care model has been adopted and used by MercyCare Health Plans Complex Case Management Program since 2009 and has been an integral part of the case management process, policies, and outcome measures.

In 2000, Nancy Skinner, RN-BC, CCM, an esteemed CMSA Past President and Board Member at the time, was instrumental in the creation of an officially recognized National Case Management Week Proclamation. She was the first to submit a request and receive a proclamation from Governor Don Sundquest declaring an official National Case Management Week in her home state of Tennessee. Since then, many CMSA chapters have followed suit in their respective cities and states.
